Tri Line Rugby would like to invite your club's 1st XV team to our first annual International Rugby Festival in Perth Western Australia from the 1st till 7th October 2007.

We have a true passion for playing, developing and enjoying the game of rugby union. We aim to create more opportunity for players and coaches to develop into better or professional rugby individuals by giving them the needed exposure to higher levels of the game. Our tournament will give your team and coaches the perfect opportunity to experience the international levels of rugby first hand on and off the field.

Their will be a total of 40 teams playing in the Festival; 16 senior club teams, 16 Golden Oldies and 8 U/21 teams. Participating teams will be from South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, Asia, Europe and the U.S.A.
